Percentage V/S CGPA Conversion formula:

For CGPA at 10 Point Scale Following formula is used: -

$$G=0.75 + (P/10) \text{ or } P=10*(G-0.75)$$

Where G is the CGPA on 10 points scale and P is the % marks.

For CGPA with scales of other points, a linear interpolation will be used
